ANNUAL REPORT ON THE WORKING OF THE SOCIETY FOR THE YEAR 2018-2019

Dear Members,

I welcome you to the 28th Annual General Meeting of the Society like every year. I also place before you the report of the performance of the Organisation during the year 2018-2019 to apprise you of the functioning of Society. To bring full clarification in support of our activities performed during the last Financial year, I have also arranged to supply to all of you the copies of audited accounts for your convenience to assess alongwith my report.

It was informed to you in our last AGM that our main target was to complete the construction of the Hospital Belgharia Vivekananda Sevasadan which is a project of Joint Venture with Belgharia Vivekananda Sevasadan and ourselves in the name and style BELGHARIA VIVEKANANDA SEVASADAN and we will concentrate our activities in organizing eye related Camps with special stress in Organising such camps in the remote areas at villages of Districts.

To organize such FREE CAMPS with distribution of Free spectacles and Free Cataract Surgery of the Identified Patients are expensive and totally depends donation Individuals/Society/Trust . Corporate Sector/Company will only provide us Fund/Donation for Capital Goods and or to create assets which will give utility to the beneficiaries.

Our endeavour and effort continues and moving from pillar to post for collecting donations from Individuals for organizing such camps. We have made our appeal in English and Bengali Version requesting person/s to donate us so that we can organize such camps where beneficiaries are from economically challenged group of society.

Moreover, we have published a Booklet for distributing amongst the public in general in order to create awareness about the Cataract and its treatment and what to do and not to do in this matter.

We have been able to organize Free Eye Check up Camps at Village Area only two at Karkai, Pingla, West Medinipur and at Belgharia Abhijatree Association , Belgharia , North 24 Parganas

However, more and more demands /requests are coming to us for organizing such camps and since our funds are not permitting, we are not responding to their requests.

As we have mainly concentrated our activities for completion of the Hospital and smoothly running its present activities as well as to organize eye related Camps only, progress of the same is in a static plight since we are not getting any donation /Financial support either from Public in general and NGOS or from Corporate Houses/benevolent persons.

Our collection of donation is very poor. Even condition may be reached to such a circumstances that we will not be in a position to pay the salary as well as organizing camps

HOSPITAL

We have shouldered a huge responsibility of constructing and completing the Hospital. But no response from Corporate Sector or benevolent donor for helping us. We are appealing to various persons /NGOs/Trusts and Corporate Houses for Fund but so far there is no positive response from them.

Hospital is now completely ready for EYE Microsurgery/Phaco Surgery. Surgeries were being taken place in regular course. Specially Phaco Surgeries demand is more than SICS (Microsurgery). But all on a sudden the Microscope meant for Eye Surgery, being old aged one, develops a problem which can not be repaired and Doctors advised for a new one.

Since Microscope Machine is the Vital instrument/devices for Microsurgery as well as Phaco Surgery, the total Surgery therefore has become a stalemate and at present Doctors are not undertaking any eye surgery. However they are attending the OPD.

We have got a donation of Rs.2.00 lakh apprx from some benevolent persons for purchasing the Microscope. But it is regret to let you know that the Microscope which we decided to purchase for Rs. 2,10,000.00 is not compatible to our PHACO MACHINE and hence we are now back geared Trying our best to contact more persons .

By this time we have been able to procure fresh Licence from the Clinical Establishment Department by providing and completing all required formalities. The present Licence is for DAY CARE and this will serve the purpose of our present functioning and we can immediately start EYE Surgery

At present patients of various wings are being treated in O.P.D. The pediatric, SKIN and eye wings are providing commendable service.

Skin Department's doctor has been rendering commendable services and he examines 25 Patients in each visit and on request two or three more. He sits at our Hospital once in a week. Patients are coming here for his consultation from far away from here

In earlier AGM I informed you that our Belgharia Vivekakanda Sevasadan had been granted MP LAD for Rs. 5,13,000.00 by Mr. Sougata Roy, Hon'ble Member of Parliament of Dum Dum Parliament Constituency for development of the Hospital Building and the necessary papers and documents were being ready for submission for releasing of the Fund. We gladly inform you that the amount was granted and the project was vetted by the Kamarhati Municipality and the work as per rule was undertaking by their direct supervision and work is still going on as some work remains pending which could not complete due to some technical reason.

Health Camps

We organized two Health Camps during the period under report as we could not manage fund for organizing more camps . .

- 1. Our ist Camp was organized at Belgharia Nilganj Road Abhijatree Association where 265 Patients' eyes were checked up. Out of which 110 No.s Patients were advised for spectacles and 25 Patients were advised for removal of cataract. 110 Nos. of spectacles were given to patients as per prescription at FREE of COST and out of 25, 19 patients were turned up for Cataract Surgery and the same successfully undertaken at Free of cost.
- 2. Our 2nd Camp was organized at Karkai, Pingla, West Medinipur where 240 Patients' eyes were checked up. Out of which 137 No.s Patients were advised for spectacles and 30 Patients were advised for removal of cataract. Free Medicines were distributed as per

Prescription to 65 Nos. of Patients . 137 Nos. of spectacles were given to patients as per prescription at FREE of COST and only 8 patients were turned up for Cataract Surgery.

CONCLUSION:

- 1. As we stated in our last meeting the there are demands from some districts far away from Kolkata for organizing FREE Eye check up camps. But due to paucity of fund we are not responding to their calls So despite of our honest intention to organize, we negate for the cause of paucity of fund.
- 2. We are trying our best to arrange donation from some people for purchasing Microscope as well for funding some amount for running our day to day activities.

For Bio metry A-Scan for Lens measurement we are trying to approach before SBI or other Banks for donation under their CSR Scheme

However, every effort and endeavour is extending to contact more and more philanthropic /benevolent persons /organization/institution for donation to organize more camps in addition to our herculean task for giving complete shape of the Hospital as we had said in our last AGM

It is really tough period to us when we need funds to continue our activities but no fund or source is seen. If it is continued then we have no other alternative but to dissolve .

Members are frequently contacted and requested to be active in case of raising Fund or to give us advice and sources for Fund . It is my humble request to all of you please take active part and tap all your sources and connections for collecting donation /fund.

I believe and hope that all will come forward spontaneously to help to turn around from the present scenario.
